



Things to Come in 2021


With the first month of 2021 behind us, Southport is looking forward to the many exciting things to come in the year ahead.

This spring, Southport will break ground for two new duplexes in the Centennaire South residential development, bringing the total number of duplexes in the neighbourhood to 8. Southport's additional 188 residential units will begin receiving new furnaces in the course of a 5-year project and 16 of these units will be upgraded and modernized as part of an annual initiative. Also in Southport's residential area, the annual Yard Beautification Contest will be held throughout the summer months, with a grand prize winner selected in August.

Select roads and streets in Southport will receive repairs, with some sections being completely repaved as a component of an annual initiative and Southport's commitment to continually upgrading on-site infrastructure. In Southport's storage complex, 6 new 40-foot units will be added to address the demand for storage in the Central Plains Region.

At the other end of Southport, we will be celebrating the Grand Opening of the newly expanded clubhouse at Southport Golf Club. Southport is planning to host weekly '9 and Dine' supper specials as well as ladies and mens leagues throughout the upcoming season.

Across from the Southport Office in the Interpretive Park, visitors can expect to see a new plane on display as well as a new, exciting addition, the Indigenous Cultural Park, which will begin to take shape this year. Southport will also be adding garbage and recycling receptacles along the paths that criss-cross throughout the community as part of our certification as a Climate Smart organization. Southport Staff Attend Climate Change Conferences

Southport Assistant Manager, Properties, Dean Rennie, recently virtually attended two conferences on climate change. The first series, held throughout November and December, was organized by the Institute of Corporate Directors (ICD) and focused on climate change and competitiveness in Canada. The four-part series discussed climate-associated risks and opportunities as well as Canadians' role in climate strategy creation and implementation.

The second conference, organized by the Manitoba Environmental Industries Association (MEIA) was held from November 24-27 and concentrated on emerging issues with climate change and how to meet new challenges, recognize opportunities and remain competitive in a changing environment.

These conferences provided a valuable learning opportunity and will allow Southport to continue making informed decisions that benefit the environment in coordination with our certification as a Climate Smart organization.




Accountant
