

Southport Celebrates Earth Day and Anniversary of Climate Smart Certification

One year ago, Southport became the first 'Climate Smart' certified organization in Manitoba. This certification was obtained through the Climate Smart training program, which included developing a Baseline GHG (greenhouse gas) Emissions Inventory and developing a reduction plan based off of that inventory. This accreditation identifies Southport as a leading organization that is tracking and taking action to reduce its carbon footprint and greenhouse gas emissions. Since our certification, many of Southport's capital projects incorporate a carbon avoidance plan or design.

Southport's new 42-lot residential development, Centenaire South, features duplex homes that are constructed with 100% electric heating and cooling systems. With this design, each home produces only 0.1 tonne of carbon per year, compared to the 5.56 tonnes each home would have produced if they were heated with natural gas.

In 2019, the twelve homes that are currently in the development would have created an output of 66.6 tonnes of carbon if they were heated with natural gas. This carbon avoidance design will be incorporated into each new home in the Centenaire South neighbourhood.



Southport's 13,600 ft² Hangar 5 was also built with the environment in mind and features 100% electric heating and cooling systems, creating only 0.4 tonnes of carbon output annually. This carbon avoidance design saves 62 tonnes of carbon equivalent per year. In 2018, Southport began planting approximately 110 trees and saplings in our Interpretive Park and around the site on an annual basis. This a continued initiative and Southport plans to plant approximately 100 trees in 2020. After growing for ten years, these

trees will have offset over 30 tonnes of carbon, which is equivalent to one year worth of carbon output for four homes heated with natural gas.



In 2019, Southport also began tracking its office paper usage with monthly reports. These reports are posted in the copier room to encourage staff to reduce the amount of paper used in the Southport Office. Throughout 2019, we saw the reduction of 9000 sheets of paper, with our tracking continuing into 2020. Office recycling is also encouraged through the placement of recycling containers at each desk.

How You Can be Climate Smart:



- Ride your bike instead of driving your car
- Plant a vegetable garden or fruit trees
- Invest in reusable straws and avoid single-use plastics and packaging

New initiatives for 2020 include moving many of our billing methods to the online or the electronic version. We are currently working to produce and send water bills electronically via email to further reduce paper usage in the Southport Office. All of Southport's coffee machines will be upgraded to have the ability to eject coffee grinds for composting purposes and brew single cups to minimize water waste. We will also be sourcing our coffee from a sustainable coffee supplier and all condiments will be purchased in bulk, reducing the waste created with single serving packing and single-use plastics.
