

Annual UAS Student Competition Returns!

At the beginning of the month, Southport hosted the Aerial Evolution Association of Canada's Unmanned Aerial Systems (UAS) Student Competition.

10 teams from Canadian universities came to put their skills to the test in hopes of winning cash prizes. This event also brought in numerous leaders from the Unmanned Aerial Vehicle industry. Students who attended the competition were given the opportunity to network and learn from the experts themselves.

During the weekend, all the participants worked endlessly to meet and complete the mission. The mission for the 2022 competition was to provide security for a large diplomatic installation in Canada, by responding to a delivery of a suspicious item and to an intrusion at a remote perimeter.

The competition is organized in two Phases including: Phase 1 Technical Competition, in which teams complete a design paper based on the Task requirements and Phase 2 Airborne Competition, in which teams physically execute the tasks. The first task was to detect and track a perimeter intruder, and the second task was to detect a device and dispose of it.



Participants used the Flightline Building as headquarters and the airport to complete all flying related tasks. Teams had to face the obstacle of Manitoba weather with high winds that caused some difficulties in trying to complete the given tasks.

After a long, and windy three days, the UAS student competition wrapped up with an awards banquet, held at Canad Inns in Portage la Prairie.

Students boarded the Portage Terriers bus which transferred them from their accommodations on and off site to the venue. Following the dinner and a comical photo overview of the weekend the organizers announced the winners.

Taking home the third place prize in the Phase 2 awards was team VAMUdeS, from Université de Sherbrooke (QC). Earning second place was team UBCO, from The University of British Columbia – Okanagan Campus (BC). Lastly, taking home the first-place award was team RUAV, from Ryerson University (ON)! Congratulations to all the participating teams and the winners of the successful weekend.

Southport is Radicle Climate Smart Certified

Southport measured its fourth greenhouse gas inventory with Climate Smart for the 2021 fiscal year (October 1, 2020 to September 30, 2021) and recorded emissions of 1,548.95 tonnes of carbon dioxide equivalent (tCO2e). Overall Southport's largest emissions source was heat (97%). Southport is Climate Smart certified for 2021.

Based on Southport's 2021 fiscal year inventory, Southport will work to minimize their emissions by focusing on strategies aimed at heating, paper use, and staff engagement.





Boomer's Legacy March

On May 5 - 6, students and staff from KF Aerospace marched from Northport to Southport in support of Boomer's Legacy.

Boomer's Legacy is named after Corporal Andrew "Boomer" Eykelenboom, a dedicated soldier and a Canadian Armed Forces medic killed by a suicide bomber on August 11, 2006. Andrew was committed to saving lives and helping the Afghan people realize freedom. His death was the catalyst to creating Boomer's Legacy to help men and women in uniform make a positive difference in the lives of others. The Climbing Club is Back!


The Central Plains RecPlex Climbing Club has returned!
