



Southport Holds Groundbreaking Ceremony for Hangar 5 Construction

June was an eventful month at Southport! Several exciting events took place on site and new construction projects are well underway. June began with one special event in particular.

On Monday, June 3, Southport hosted a groundbreaking ceremony to formally announce the construction of our new 13,600sq ft hangar, Hangar 5. The ceremony was held in front of the construction site along Musketeer Road W in Southport.

The new hangar will offer fixed base operation services such as fueling, towing and de-icing, complete with a lounge. It will feature in-floor radiant heating and LED lighting, allowing the hangar to operate at a drastically reduced carbon emission rate. This is a testament to Southport's recent certification as a Climate Smart Certified organization.

The hangar is scheduled to be completed in November of this year with space available for lease. Southport is thrilled to announce that the first tenant of this new hangar will be Simplot. This new hangar, a \$2.4 million investment, will further economic development and airport expansion at Southport.





July Spotlight: Lower Legs

The upcoming muscle of the month for July is the lower leg. This portion of the leg is divided into four compartments: anterior, lateral, posterior and deep posterior. Through evolution, the lower leg has become adapted for efficient bipedalism such as walking or running. The anterior compartment holds the tibia bone in the anterior and pulls the toes and feet upward. The lateral compartment pulls the toes and feet outward. The calf muscles in the posterior compartment attach to the Achilles tendon, and the deep posterior pulls the foot inward and flexes the toes.
