

Each team is considered a "company" that must make a pitch to the "customer," the competition judges, as to why their company should be selected to solve the problem.

In the 2020 competition, teams will focus on developing an Unmanned Aerial System (UAS) capable of delivering supplies to remote medical clinics.

For the past 10 years, the competition has be held in two altering locations, Southport and Alma, Quebéc. Southport is proud to support and host this event.

September Spotlight: Sartorius Muscle

The upcoming muscle of the month for October is the sartorius muscle. This muscle is also known as the honeymoon muscle or the tailor's muscle. It is a long, superficial muscle that runs down the length of the thigh in the anterior compartment. It is the longest muscle in the human body. The sartorius muscle can move the hip joint and knee joint, but all of its actions are weak. At the hip, it can flex, weakly abduct, and laterally rotate the thigh. At the knee, it can flex the leg.
