Southport Holds Ceremony and Commemoration for National Day of Truth and Reconciliation

On September 30, Southport held a ceremony and commemoration for the inaugural National Day of Truth and Reconciliation. The ceremony took place at the new Four Winds Cultural Centre, located in Southport's Interpretive Park, across from the Southport Office.

The day began with a traditional Pipe Ceremony and blessing, performed by Darryl Taylor, Knowledge Keeper, and Cornell Pashe, Indigenous Community Coordinator of Portage Community Revitalization Corporation (PCRC).

Following the Pipe Ceremony, speeches were made honouring National Day of Truth and Reconciliation by Doug McLennan, Chair, Southport Board of Directors, Irvine Ferris, Mayor, City of Portage la Prairie, Peggy May, CEO, Southport Aerospace Inc., Eric Pashe, Chief, Dakota Tipi First Nation, Donny Smoke, Chief, Dakota Plains First Nation, and Cornell Pashe, Indigenous Community Coordinator, PCRC.

During the ceremony, Peggy May, CEO, Southport Aerospace Inc., and Colby Orchard, Director, FAC



Engagement, were asked to join Darryl Taylor, Knowledge Keeper, and were honoured by two elders, survivors of the Residential Schools, with sacred eagle feathers.

Indigenous artists, Dakota Hostiles and Lydia Gork, attended the ceremony offering songs in prayer while those in attendance were asked to stand and join an honouring circle to participate in a group smudge and



traditional tobacco offering.

The ceremony was concluded with Jacinda Houle, wearing a traditional Jingle Dress, blessing the grounds with dance while a Thank You song was performed.

Following the formal proceedings, a feast was offered to all dignitaries and guests.

The construction of the Four Winds Cultural Centre addresses a long-time need in the community and supports Addiction Foundation Manitoba (AFM), located in Southport.

Currently the centre features a sweat lodge and a 30-foot teepee. Construction of a large community picnic shelter will begin in October.

KAIROS Blanket Exercise

On Thursday, October 14, Southport staff will be participating in the KAIROS Blanket Exercise program. The KAIROS Blanket Exercise program is a unique, participatory history lesson, developed in collaboration with Indigenous Elders, knowledge keepers, and educators, that fosters truth, understanding, respect and reconciliation among Indigenous and non-Indigenous peoples.

The Blanket Exercise covers more than 500 years in an experiential workshop that aims to foster understanding about our shared history as Indigenous and non-Indigenous peoples.

Everyone is actively involved as they use specific background icons that represent the various historical and current experiences of First Nations, Inuit and later Métis peoples. This program is highly regarded by Indigenous leaders across Canada and was selected for its unique and collaborative approach to fostering awareness and education.

Climate Smart Corner

Southport has started a five year plan to replace natural gas furnaces, that are reaching the end of serviceability. With more efficient and reliable electric forced air furnaces in 186 residential units, the project will see an estimated annual reduction of 607.42 tonnes of CO2 equivalent being released into the atmosphere. This project also has a climate resilience aspect. Southport is running the power supply line for each unit underground replacing the overhead power lines that are sometimes damaged in wind storms or heavy snow falls. Both of these items are in line with Southport's Climate Smart commitment to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and to prepare for a changing climate.

Construction of the two newest Centenaire South duplexes continues! In September, driveway paving, placement of sod, and interior drywalling have been completed with finishings underway.

Southport Runway Construction

The inner runway rehabilitation project began on Monday, August 30, and was completed on Thursday, September 30.

The project entailed the narrowing and rehabilitation of runway 13L (left) and 31R (right), also known as the inner runway.

Maple Leaf Construction milled the old asphalt, reclaimed, shaped, and compacted it to prepare for paving. The runway was paved with asphalt and repainted according to the new dimensions.

Canadian Base Operations conducted an operational inspection and all runways and taxiways were opened to full operations on Friday, October 1. The final inspection with consultants is scheduled for Thursday, October 14 when the project will officially close.
