



2018 was a great year in Southport with many exciting things occurring in the community. These included new additions to Southport's amenities, upgrades to buildings and several events.


Here are our top 5 highlights from the year:

- 1 The most significant part of the year for Southport was being named as a continuing location for the military's new training services known as Future Aircrew Training or FAcT. Southport hosted several guests from the FAcT team on a tour of the Southport facilities this month.
- 2 Visitors and residents of Southport may have noticed two new buildings that are now available for rent in



Centennaire South. These new rental properties offer upscale amenities and finishings in a safe, peaceful country setting only minutes from Portage la Prairie. Two additional units are currently under construction and will be available for rent April 1.

- **3** The Manitoba Airshow made an appearance in Southport this year. One of the highlights of the airshow and a crowd favourite, the Canadian Forces Snowbirds, made an appearance again, dropping and flipping through the sky. The event was well-attended and made possible with the help of over 400 community volunteers.
- 4 The Central Plains RecPlex had an exciting year with the grand reopening of Southport Bowl. The newly renovated 5 pin bowling alley features 5 lanes of bowling suitable for all ages. The many upgrades to the facility include a new accessible entrance through the main doors of the RecPlex, a new, modern look and feel, digital scoring and added food and beverage services.

The renovations in this building included fresh paint, new flooring, major upgrades to the common kitchen areas on each floor, and the creation of private bathrooms for each individual room.
