With this, we are pleased to share the following 20 notable projects and initiatives that occurred at Southport in 2020.

Hangar 5 Grand Opening

January 22 marked the grand opening of Hangar 5, nine months after the site's groundbreaking ceremony in April. This hangar is home to one of Southport's newest tenants, J.R. Simplot Company.

Terrier Sponsorship Night

Southport's annual Portage Terriers hockey team sponsorship night at Stride Place included a booth along the concourse and an aviation-themed ice activity during intermission. The Terriers came away with a 3-0 win, the perfect end to a fun night cheering on the local hockey team!

COVID-19 Donations

CFPD Advertisement Sponsorship


