



GARBAGE AND RECYCLING PICK-UP INFO

Garbage

Garbage will be picked up every TUESDAY except when it falls on: Canada Day, Remembrance Day, Christmas or New Year's Day.

- Garbage to be curbside by 7:00 a.m.
- Maximum 5 BAGS
- If the garbage truck cannot pick up the garbage on a designated garbage day, please bring your garbage in from the curb and it will be picked up the following Tuesday.

Bag Size

1 bag is constituted as: 1 large black garbage bag or 1 garbage can

- Branches and tree clippings, 1 bundle that is easily accessible and no longer than 4 feet in length.
- Furniture (small pieces only).

Note

- Appliances will not be picked up
- Leaves and lawn clippings will only be picked up if within the 5 bag limit.
- One recycling container is supplied for each residential unit.

Recycling

Recycling is picked up on the highlighted green days below to eliminate missed pick ups due to holidays. Please refer to reverse for a list of recyclables. Southport pick ups are under calendar 4A.

CURBSIDE COLLECTION OR DEPOT DROP OFF

ELIGIBLE MATERIALS

Newspaper (flyers and inserts)
Telephone books
Magazine and catalogues (including glossy paper)
Office paper (bond paper, envelopes, kraft paper, etc.)
Shredded office paper
Boxboard (cereal boxes, laundry detergent boxes, toy boxes, shoe boxes, etc.)
Corrugated cardboard
Aluminum cans
Steel/tin cans (no need to remove labels)
Glass jar and bottles (liquor bottles and glass jars) (please remove all lids)
Gable top beverage cartons (milk, milk products and juice cartons)
Tetra pak containers (beverage containers)

PET #1 Plastic (soft drink bottles, some food and personal care product containers)
HDPE #2 Plastic containers (milk jugs, some food and personal care products)
LDPE #4 Plastic (containers and lids from margarine, yogurt and other food products)
PP #5 Plastic (margarine, yogurt and other food products)
#7 Plastic containers (ketchup, syrup, margarine containers, etc.)

ALL containers should be rinsed, and the caps loosened.

Portage Recycling now offers paper shredding. Cost is \$35.00 an hour. This is a great way to destroy important old financial documents in a safe environment. Call for more details.
